

NOMINATIONS/ELECTIONS COMMITTEE

Purpose Statement:

The purpose of the Nominations/Elections Committee is to seek and search out qualified individuals serving on the existing Virginia Association of Resource Conservation and Development Councils that are willing to lead and serve as an officer for a two-year term. These potential nominees should have demonstrated the skills necessary to lead the Virginia Association forward in the advancement of the organization's goals.

It is the general policy of the VARC&DC to have successional officers who first serve as treasurer, then are nominated for vice chairperson and then nominated for chairperson. When extenuating circumstances occur, the Nominations Committee is authorized to vary from this policy.

It is the general policy of the VARC&DC that the leadership positions of officers rotate through all of the Councils that are members of the Association. The Nominations Committee will maintain a history of the officers and their Councils so that this rotation can be followed. When extenuating circumstances occur, the Nominations Committee is authorized to vary from this policy in selecting leadership nominees who are well qualified.
